#### **JBS increases product recall in the US to reassure customers**

JBS (JBSS3 and JBSAY) expanded an initial voluntary recall of about 41 000 lbs (about 18 tons) of primal cuts to include a further 380 000 lbs (about 172 tons) produced on April 21 2009 in its Greeley Colorado plant due to suspected bacteria contamination. The recall is precautionary and is being carried out spontaneously by the Company as a mark of respect for its customers.

Analysis showed a possible E Coli O157 H7 contamination in a fraction of primal (whole) cuts produced on the mentioned date and although the Company believes that the vast majority of this product is already consumed, the recall is being made to reassure consumers. Procedures at the plant have been revised and no further evidence of possible contamination has been found in product produced prior to or since that date.

JBS always fully cooperates with the competent authorities in the USA (The USDA, United States Department of Agriculture and FSIS, Food Safety and Inspection Service) and in all countries where it operates in order to guarantee the safety of its range of products.
